## **NOTICE**

In view of the National Pandemic of Covid-19, strict measures imposed by the Government (closure of education institutions, lockdown, curfew, maintenance of social distancing etc.) have to be followed in letter & spirit. Consequently students of B.Sc. (H) Agriculture Year-IV could not complete their ongoing trainings in various fields as the college closed mid of March as per Government notification.

This being the crucial stage of final year students who have to seek admission in post graduation or find future avenues of their career after graduation, timely completion of the training syllabi becomes a priority. Hence the following modifications in the training curriculum & evaluation were approved after deliberations:

- 1. No change in Curriculum & Evaluation criterion required in case of RAWE-411 (General Orientation Course, AIA-414 (Agro-Industrial Attachment) as the training of both these components concluded before 15 March, 2020.
- 2. In case of RAWE-413 (Village Attachment), of the 8 weeks allotted, students have undergone 4 weeks training in the adopted villages. The students will hence forth prepare comprehensive reports of the 4 weeks agro-interventions studied (i.e. Socio economic intervention, Agronomic interventions, Agricultural Extension intervention, Soil Intervention). - 3. There will be change in Curriculum & Evaluation criterion of RAWE-412 (Plant Clinic) & AIA-415 (Agro-Industrial Training). In case of RAWE-412, the coordinator of Plant Clinic will come out with practical type of topics to be carried through online system. Students will submit an assignment of the same. For further information, contact Prof. Kiranjot Kaur.

In case of AIA-415, the students will prepare assignment on the Agro-industry, he/she had proposed to undergo training in. For further information contact Dr. Gurbax Singh

4. In case of ELMs (422 to 428), of the 10 weeks allotted, students have undergone 8 weeks training. Course coordinator will come out with practical type of topics yet to be covered through online system. Students will submit Comprehensive Report of the training as per the format prescribed by the respective instructor. Evaluation criteria remain the same. These modifications have been made due to National Crisis of Covid-19 and will be effective for the session 2019-20 (even semester) students only considering it an abnormal year.
