M.Phil Political Science

Eligibility: Masters Degree in Political Science of GNDU or equivalent degree of a recognized university or allied subjects, with at least 55% marks (6.18 CGPA out of 10) or 50% marks (5.62 CGPA out of 10) for SC/ST candidates.

Structure of the Course: The students have to appear in three compulsory Papers, Paper-I, Paper-II and Paper IV. For Paper-III, the students have to choose one paper from Option-i, ii & iii. Paper IV is Inter- disciplinary Course. Each Paper consists of 100 marks (Theory 80 marks & Internal Assessment 20 marks). Minimum Pass Percentage in each paper would be 50 percent. In Semester 1,
