Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) Action Taken Report on feedback Analysis (2017-18)

The feedback was obtained from various stakeholders and feedback analysis report was prepared. The suggestions received from various stakeholders were discussed with college authorities and then appropriate actions were taken.

The suggestions received from various stakeholders i.e. Alumni, Teachers, Students & Employers and the actions taken by the college regarding these suggestion are given below:

Feedback Analysis: Alumni

As per feedback analysis report (2017-18), 35% of alumni strongly agreed, whereas 61% agreed that programs being run by the college were helpful in developing the overall personality of the students. 41% strongly agreed and 53% agreed that curriculum was effective in developing entrepreneurial /leadership skills of the students. 54% alumni strongly agreed that reading material regarding curriculum was easily available to the students. 28% considered library facilities as excellent, while 58% regarded them as good. According to 28% alumni, Internet lab facilities were excellent, while 58% found them as good. 52% strongly agreed that courses taught were helpful to go in for higher studies/career planning.

Feedback Analysis: Employer

According to feedback analysis report (2017-18), 45% of the employers considered interview skills and group discussion skills of the students as excellent, while 67% regarded communication skills of the students to be excellent/good. 46% employers strongly agreed that syllabus was relevant from employment point of view. 36% strongly agreed, while 46% agreed that curriculum was designed according to the needs of the industry and market. 73% employers strongly agreed /agreed that curriculum was effective in the developing entrepreneurial/ leadership skills, while 72% strongly agreed/agreed that course content had enough scope for the development of analytical, logical, technical and creative skills of the students..

Feedback Analysis: Teachers

According to feedback analysis report (2017-2018), 49% of the teachers strongly agreed that syllabus had a good balance between theory and lab work. ICT skills for teaching were found high in 35% teachers, while these were moderate in 59% cases. Awareness about newer approaches in teaching was found high in 59% teachers, while it was moderate in 40% cases. 48% teachers strongly agreed that

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curriculum had enough scope to develop analytical/logical /technical/ creative skills of the students. 48% teachers strongly agreed, while 51% agreed that current syllabus was need based. 53% teachers strongly agreed that curriculum was effective in developing entrepreneurial/leadership skills in students, while 64% considered student career guidance as excellent

Feedback Analysis: Students

According to feedback analysis report (2017-18), 52% of the students strongly agreed that syllabus generated interest in the subject area. 37% strongly agreed, while 55% agreed with the availability of learning resources (library, labs, ICT facilities) in the college. 43% students strongly agreed, while 46% agreed that course related activities like internship/field visits/guest lectures/assignments/ seminars/others were relevant for developing skills needed for further employment/self-employment. 33% students regarded the conduct of practicals to be excellent, while 61% considered it as good. Student-teacher ratio was considered excellent by 49% students, while conduct of examination was

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regarded excellent by 43% students. 88% students strongly agreed/agreed that syllabus was a good balance between theory and application.
