NCC AND NSS WINGS

The NCC and NSS are active units of the college, the NCC (Army Wing) celebrated the 2nd Anniversary of Surgical Strike in the Campus where Snipper Rifles and other arms were displayed for cadets. A total of 53 cadets were enrolled and 28 cadets appeared and passed "C" certificate exam. 25 cadets of NCC (Naval Wing) participated in the Combined Annual Training Camp (CATC) in June 2018 at Ropar.
