Academic Year: 2018-19

Khalsa College Amritsar, is preparing to apply for the extension of Autonomous Status to University Grants Commission, New Delhi. It was accredited by NAAC with 'A' grade in 2003-04, re-accredited with 'A' grade with CGPA 3.41 in the scale of '4' in the year 2011-12. The college has been recently reaccredited 'A' grade with CGPA 3.47 in the scale of 4 in its third cycle. Khalsa College was conferred with Autonomous status in 2013. It also has the honour of College with Potential for Excellence (CPE), Heritage College and Star College status. The College has impacted the various core areas with the overall growth and improvement. The IQAC has been quite active and holding meetings with different stakeholders.

I Curricular Aspects

1. 177 new undergraduate and post graduate courses have been added to UG and PG programmes.
2. The feedback from various stakeholders is taken for Curricular design.
3. The various academic bodies include experts from industry, academics and other stake holders who give suggestions for the curriculum enrichment.

II Teaching, Learning, and Evaluation

1. The college has an inclusive admission policy catering to diverse student groups.
2. The college provides a large number of sponsored scholarships and freeships from its own funds in addition to the scholarships and free-ships to the students by the state government.
3. The orientation programmes are organized in the beginning of the academic session and addressed by the Principal and respective Deans of faculties.
4. The students are continuously evaluated through tests, assignments, quizzes, seminars and semester/final examinations.
5. The participation of the faculty in international and national seminars has gone up.



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III Research, Consultancy and Extension

1. Research committee is holding its meetings regularly.
2. 122 research articles have been published in various journals whereas 56 books have been published.
3. A Research Centre has been established.
4. Grant has been received from UGC under CPE grant.

IV Infrastructure and Learning Resources

1. 10 classrooms and 6 laboratories have been constructed.
2. Rs. 5 crores have been spent on physical and academic infrastructure and Rs. 15 lakhs on library infrastructure.

V Student Support and Progression

1. Number of students are benefitting from scholarships/freeships have increased.
2. The male and female students in the college are almost equal in number.
3. SC and OBC students are also provided incentives as per government rules.
4. Many students have excelled in sports and cultural activities at local, state, national and international levels.
5. College has bagged Shaheed Bhagat Singh Trophy due to maximum contribution towards MAKAT Trophy by GNDU, Amritsar.
6. College has won Overall Sports Championship of GNDU, Amritsar.
7. College became overall sports champion of GNDU, Amritsar
8. Runners up in Zonal Youth Festival of the affiliating University.
9. 650 students awarded with Post Matric Scholarship Scheme, 247988/ students were awarded Institutional Scholarships and Freeships. 103 students were supported by NGO Scholarships and 10 students were recipients of Philanthropists Scholarships.

1. Various academic bodies are fully functional in running the college affairs effectively.
2. The day to day working of the college is done through e-governance.
3. The ICT resources are fully utilised.
