Khalsa College has completed Seven years as an autonomous institution. It has four faculties at the present, namely Arts, Science, Commerce and Agriculture, besides which a programme in Physiotherapy is also running successfully. The college has UGC-CPE status, DST Star Scheme and DST-FIST. IQAC continues to be active. The College recently got extension in its autonomous status by UGC, New Delhi.
