Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) Action Taken Report on feedback Analysis (2022-23)

The feedback was obtained from various stakeholders and feedback analysis report was prepared. The suggestions received from various stakeholders were discussed with college authorities and then appropriate actions were taken.

The suggestions received from various stakeholders i.e. Alumni, Teachers, Students & Employers and the actions taken by the college regarding these suggestion are given below:

Feedback Analysis: Alumni

As per feedback analysis report (2022-23), 32% of the alumni correspondents strongly agreed ,while 56% agreed that the course curriculum fulfilled the expectations of the students.

33% strongly agreed, while 53% agreed that the programmes being run by the college were helpful in developing the personality of the students. 87% strongly agreed/agreed that the curriculum was effective in developing innovative ideas among the students.

92% correspondents (alumni) strongly agreed/agreed that the reading material regarding curriculum was easily available to the students. 46% strongly agreed that most of the teachers took extra efforts to make students understand the subject. 54% are of the opinion that the quality of the teachers was excellent. 88% considered overall campus life as excellent/good, while 60% of them considered internet lab facilities as excellent/good.

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Feedback Analysis: Employers

According to feedback analysis report (2022-23), 54% of the employers (correspondents) considered subject knowledge of the students as excellent, while 35% considered it good. 81% considered the communication skills of the students as excellent/good. Presentation skills/group discussion performance were considered excellent by 46% of the correspondents. Around 84% of the correspondents considered the problem solving skills/ interview performance of the students as excellent/good. 89% of them considered the ability of the students to take up extra responsibility as excellent/good. 77% employers strongly agreed/agreed that the course content had enough scope for the development of analytical, logical, technical and creative skills of the students. It is also strongly agreed/agreed by 81% of the employers (correspondents) that the curriculum was effective in developing entrepreneurial /leadership skills of the students. As far as employability of syllabus is concerned. 46% employers strongly agreed while 42% agreed that the syllabus was relevant for generating employability.

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Feedback Analysis: Teachers

As per feedback analysis report (2022-23), 65% of the correspondents (teachers) strongly agreed that the current syllabus is need based and has good balance between theory and laboratory work. 73% strongly agreed that the course outcomes were well defined and clear to the students and staff. 66% teachers strongly agreed, while 31% agreed that the curriculum is effective in developing entrepreneurial/leadership skills among the students. 73% teachers strongly agreed, while 26% agreed that curriculum design, Teaching learning assessment & examination were being effectively carried out on time.

76% of the correspondents (teachers) are of the opinion that students-career guidance was excellent, whereas 55% considered ICT skills for teaching as high. 65% correspondents strongly agreed that course activities (Internship /field visits/guests lectures/assignments/seminars /others) as relevant for the development of various skills needed for employment/self-employment.

Feedback Analysis: Students

As per feedback analysis report (2022-23), 64% of the correspondents (students) considered teaching methods followed by the teachers as excellent. 49% considered the conduct of practicals as excellent. 53% strongly agreed, while 40% agreed that the syllabus was designed in accordance with the needs of national and global aspects. 57% of the correspondents strongly agreed that the course content had enough scope for the development of analytical, logical, technical and creative skills of the students. 54% correspondents (students) strongly agreed that the syllabi of various courses covered the recent trends and development, while 56% strongly agreed that syllabus was a good balance between theory and practical. 92% strongly agreed/agreed that the Internship/field visits/guest lectures/assignments/seminars/others were relevant for the development of skills needed for employment/ self-employment. 94% students also strongly agreed/agreed that the syllabus prepared and motivated the students to pursue higher education/ research
